We Survive has a rural property used for training, wellness education and support.

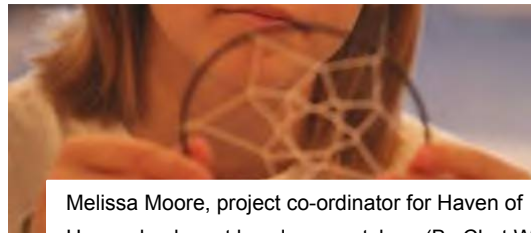

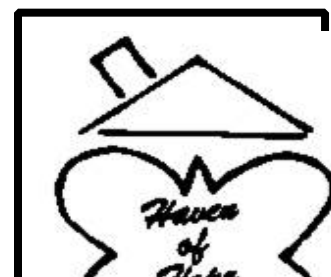
